A unique capacity-building program where you get to learn from virtual field visit, mentored by professionals, and have full creativity in designing out-of-the-box solutions with your teammates.


The program will take **Sembalun District near the Rinjani-Lombok Biosphere Reserve and UGGp, West Nusa Tenggara** as the case study area. A mix of water-related issues lies there, waiting for your concept solutions to achieve a sustainable environment in 2030 and beyond.

The challenge will look into these three topics: Water for Food, Water for Living, and Water and Safety.

### What you need to prepare?

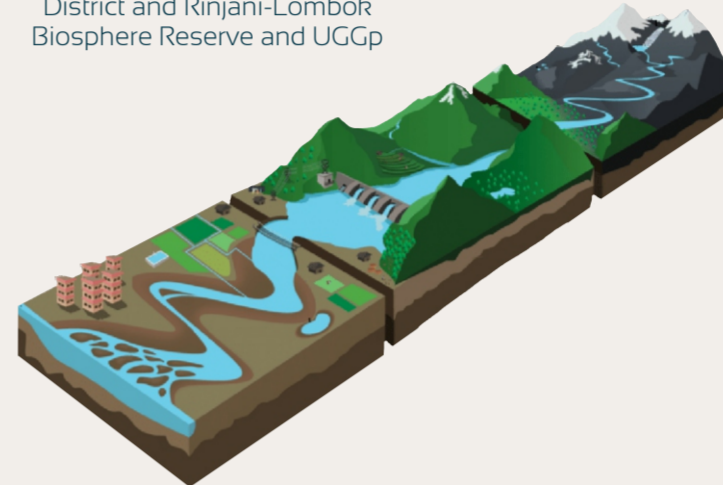
- Curriculum vitae (CV) in pdf file

## Challenge - Phase I

### Introduction and virtual field visits

#### First & second day

Expert presentation and virtual field visit to the Sembalun District and Rinjani-Lombok Biosphere Reserve and UGGp



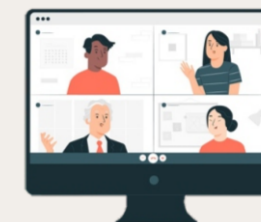
#### Third day

Problem identification by participants, consultation with experts



#### Forth day

Stakeholder management game, participants' presentation on problem identification (and concept)



## Challenge - Phase II

### Online designing and mentoring



Participants will work on their design remotely



For 4 weeks, participants will also receive online mentoring from pool of mentors, and get progress-monitoring during the Phase II period



During Phase II, participants and mentor will work through the Indonesia Water Portal [[www.indonesiawaterportal.com/unescochallenge](http://www.indonesiawaterportal.com/unescochallenge)]



At the end of Phase II, the participants will be invited to present their set of solutions/ideas before the final presentation on 12 November 2021

## Challenge - Phase III

### Final presentation



Teams will present their designs in front of the judges which comprised of experts from the government and private sector



In the end, the panel of judges will select one team as the winner of the UNESCO Water Resilience Challenge 2021



The winning team will have a chance to present their ideas at the 13<sup>th</sup> SeaBRnet meeting

## How to register and upload your files

- 1 Fill in the registration form through [bit.ly/UNESCOchallenge](https://bit.ly/UNESCOchallenge) or click on the Instagram bio.
- 2 Go to [www.indonesiawaterportal.com](http://www.indonesiawaterportal.com) and create an account by clicking on “Register” button on the upper-right corner. Once your registration is completed, please regularly check you email because the account verification can take up to 2 days.  
For participants who already have an account, skip this Step 2 and sign into your account.
- 3 Join the UNESCO Water Resilience Challenge group via [indonesiawaterportal.com/unescochallenge](http://indonesiawaterportal.com/unescochallenge) then sign in using your account. Click on the “Join” button to join the group.
